Japura Scholarship Fund (JSF) of JAAI

Scholarships are awarded based on the financial needs, academic success, and future plans of the applicants. These awards are open to undergraduates of **ALL FACULTIES** of the University.

Amount of Scholarship Award

Selected undergraduates will receive a monthly payment of approximately **Rs 3,000** over a period of 10 months.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for consideration, an applicant must:

- provide evidence that applicant has financial needs and requires assistance to continue university education;
- be registered and enrolled as a full time undergraduate with the University of Sri Jayewardenepura, Sri Lanka as of 1st December 2024;
- have an excellent academic record;
- demonstrate sporting excellence and social engagement;

Selection Criteria

Selection of scholarship recipients will be based on 3 main criteria.

- Applicant's Income/Financial considerations – (Weight 40%)
- Academic Excellence (Weight 40%)
- Sporting Excellence and Social Engagement (Weight 20%)

- Gather scanned copies of following supporting documents:
 - Copies of academic transcripts.
 - A letter from the University Welfare Department. (Alternatively, a letter from a Grama Sevaka, a Priest or a JAAI Member confirming the need for financial support will be considered if the applicant is unable to obtain a letter from the University Welfare Department due to reasonable grounds).
 - A Personal Statement (not exceeding 500 words) indicating why the applicant deserves to receive a scholarship.
- Submit Application together with all supporting documents to University Welfare Department.
